# Kine of the state of the state

### Ear Warmer ... BEGINNER

Finished Size: 4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" (12 cm) wide Fits 21" (53.5 cm) head circumference

#### **MATERIALS**

Medium Weight Yarn [3.5 ounces, 280 yards (100 grams, 256 meters) per skein]: One skein Knook size I (5.5 mm) Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** In Stockinette Stitch

(knit one row, purl one row), 15 stitches =  $4^{3}/_{4}$ " (12 cm)

### **EAR WARMER**

Ch 15.

Pick up 14 sts on foundation ch: 15 sts.

Row 1: Purl across.

Row 2 (Right side): Knit across.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until Ear Warmer measures approximately 21" (53.5 cm) from cast on edge, ending by working Row 1.

Bind off all stitches **loosely** in **knit**, leaving a long end for sewing.

With **right** side of Ear Warmer together, whipstitch ends. Turn **right** side out.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch(s) chain(s)

cm centimeters

K knit

mm millimeters

P purl

st(s) stitch(es)

() or [] — contains explanatory remarks.

colon (:) — the number(s) given after a colon at the end of a row denote(s) the number of stitches you should have on that row.

right vs. wrong side — On the finished piece, the right side of your work is the side that the public will see.

#### **GAUGE**

Gauge is a measurement of the number of stitches and rows in a 4" (10 cm) square piece in the pattern you're working. Finding the exact gauge is not important for this pattern as the Ear Warmer can be a little larger or smaller without changing the overall effect.
