Monkey Mug Cozy Pattern



A customer requested a Monkey mug cozy – I think it turned out pretty good *If you find any issues, please let me know – I'm not perfect :)

Materials & Tools:

- (2) Buttons of your choice, I believe mine are 7/8" For Closure
- (2) Black Buttons for Eyes ¾"
- G Hook 4.25 mm
- Yarn in Colors of your choice I used Vanna's Choice "Chocolate"
 Small amount of Beige & Black
- Tapestry needle

Stitches:

SI st - Slip Stitch

St - Stitch

Ch - Chain

Sc – Single Crochet

Hdc – Half Double Crochet

Mug Cozy Pattern:

Chain 36

Row 1: Hdc in 2nd ch from hook and across, Ch 1n turn (35)

Row 2-9: Hdc across, ch 1, turn (35)

At end of **ROW 9**, chain 16, sl st to same st, sc down to 2nd to last st, Chain 16, sl st to same st

Attach buttons on opposite size

Snout: Light Beige

Chain 8

Round 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, Sc in the next 5 sts, 3 sc in last ch, now working on opposite side, sc in the next 5 sts, make 2 sc in last st, sl st to 1st sc and ch 1

Row 2: 2 sc in same st, sc in the next 5, make 2 sc in 3 sts, make sc in next 5 sts, make 2 sc in last 2 sts, sl st and ch 1 Row 3: 2 sc in same st, 2 Sc in the next st, sc in the next 6 sts, make 2 sc in next 5 sts, make sc in next 6 sts, make 2 sc in the next 3 sts, sl st, ch 1

Row 4: Sc in same st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 9 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 9 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next s

Stitch on mouth with black yarn

Ears (make 2):

Round 1: 8 Hdc in Magic Circle, sl st, ch 1 Round 2: 2 Hdc in each st, sl st, Ch 1

Round 3: Sc in ea st, do not sl st

Tie off and leave a tail long enough to attach wing to cozy
